




Among the main project's activities are to be mentioned the activation of four Didactic Centres, one in each partner country, in which creative and didactic workshop will be carried out for teachers and pupils of primary and secondary school institutions, and the set up of Sustainable Development Museums in areas adjacent to the didactic centres or in places of particular environmental interest, where the materials produced during the creative workshops will be presented, through artistic installations and different means: video projections, concerts, performances.
