Global education labs on the 7th MDG achieved great success in Teramo! More than 450 students from infant, primary and secondary schools from the Province of Teramo have been the protagonists, together with teachers and educators, of a first cycle of didactic workshops focused on the topic of



sustainable development and carried out with the use of participatory and learnercentered pedagogical techniques. Labs and workshops dealt with relevant topics at the heart of international debate, such as: sustainable and respectful use of water reserves, biodiversity preservation, renewable energies, sustainable tourism,



extreme poverty and the phenomenon of slums. Co-managed by Giulia Lonardi and Roberta Morosillo, young experts working for the NGO ProgettoMondo Mlal, global education labs have provided youngsters with theoretical tools to be further nurtured during the subsequent artistic experience.

NOVA GORICA





Fifty teachers from 10 primary and secondary schools in the Goriška region, who decided to take part in We Are the Planet project, attended the first teacher training, held in Nova Gorica in August 2012.

Due to a large number of participating teachers, they were divided in two groups. The first day of training was dedicated to the presentation of examples of good practices in the local area. On a field trip,





the participants visited a hydroelectric power plant, waste water treatment plant, water station, solar power station, small wind farm, waste management centre, and E-hiša (the house of experiments). The training also included presentation of didactic units, which was delivered by experts and guest lecturers. In November 2012, the first didactic workshops took place.


Most workshops have been held at the

didactic centre, while some creative laboratories (human flags, Earthbeats, creative workshops) have taken place at schools. The experts prepared some experiments related to water and sustainable energy. Children have been actively involved in the experiments and have shown plenty of enthusiasm and creativity, which is reflected in the works created during artistic and experimental laboratories.









Ecoslogong is a project ideated by Maria Crispal as a creative space in which to socialize and to confront culture complexity, different languages and worldwide issues. Through the study of the body and the elaboration of the self-image the participants will deepen aspects linked to their personalities and to their unique way to see the world. An original way to enter in the contemporary imaginary and











the magic that surrounds our life. The people are responsible for creating and representing graphically their logo-slogans dedicated to our Planet. The logo-slogans will be showed during a photographic performance in which the body becomes the triumphal pole hoisting the flag of thoughts, and the expressive face standing out in the foreground becomes the icon of the power of ideas: the Human Flags! The main aspect is the connection with the artist Maria Crispal, whose image represents the Big Mother who creates the new world. During her performances, Maria Crispal will sing the people's slogans in all languages: the ecoslogongs (eco=ecology, economy, echo of the people slogong= slogan+song/gong).

Earthbeats is the union of the words beat and earth. Earth as consistence, going through, place of narrations. Beat as what exists, soften by bones, muscles and skin, from birth to death

The project originates from an idea of EmidioSciannella,thankstotheexperience in Solstizio and the participation of Julia Kent, who shares its developments and consequences. The project is founded on the creation and collection



of spontaneous sounds by pupils taking part in projects and workshops on specific issues (wars, emigration, water problems, environmental issues). These sounds are later re-elaborated by musicians and transformed into original assemblages which will be introduced into the pop or underground distribution chains; any revenue will be assigned to support the social projects in the world.

The Earthbeats Lab offers the possibility of conveying individual interpretations of a social, global, and local problem through the creation or reproduction of a sound. It involves pupils with different ages (6-18 years old) in more than one area of the planet, thanks to educational paths that employ a method characterized by the use of artistic languages as means for giving voice to the individual views and for harmonizing them. The network



contributes to foster and continue the narrations that arise, blend, and take a new life in the interaction and sharing. The laboratories are linked to projects funded and supported by Public Institutions (European Union, Local Authorities, etc.) and develop with the support of school institutions, teachers, educational agencies and operators.
